Composer Notes

This setting must pulse with the vitality and vigor of the resurrection! It is never slow, though it should also be flowing and lyrical. The verses especially ought to nearly interrupt the end of the refrain, and sound strident and forceful in their speech-like declamation. Note the two different translations of the verses and the two different refrain texts, which greatly expand the usability of the piece. The simpler tones which set the *Lectionary* translation of the verses could easily take on any Gospel Acclamation verse during the whole of their Easter season, or indeed any time of the year (outside Lent, of course). The vibrancy of this acclamation fits in well for use at baptisms within Mass and at any other moments of liturgical praise and rejoicing.

Usage note: While the sets of verses may be sung with either refrain, they are not meant to be mixed and matched; sing one set or the other during any given liturgy.


